



College Academy Permission Slip

This document will permit your child to participate in the Rittman College Academy program. By signing this document, it is understood that:

- Both parent and student have read the college academy brochure.
- Both parent and student have reviewed the CA Basic Expectations document from teachers.
- Permission is granted for your child to come and go from Rittman property as necessary. While the student is off campus, including in a vehicle, liability rests with the student and parents/guardians.
- College Academy is a privilege and can be taken away at any time by administration for poor choices and/or academic performance.
- College Credit Plus (CCP) rule changes by the college and/or state would supersede any stipulations in the brochure.
- Students must attend any required meetings by the school (senior seminar, class meetings, etc.) unless they have a prearranged excuse.
- Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in order to keep college academy privileges. Students dropping below that mark at the end of each semester will be assigned study halls/intervention during open periods.
- Students are responsible to actively check school email as well as college emails so that they are aware of what is happening in class/school. Failing to do so may result in missed opportunities and/or removal from the college academy program.
