Welcome

College Credit Plus College Academy

- College Credit Plus allows all students in grades 7-12 to enroll full or part-time at approved public colleges, universities, or technical schools. Students must meet college entrance requirements in order to participate. Students can earn high school and college credits at the same time.
- Limits college credits earned to 30 per year (up to 120 credits while in the program).

What is CCP?

- 3 or 4 college credits = 1 high school credit
- 2 college credits = .67 high school credit
- 1 college credit = .33 high school credit

- High school credit granted to meet graduation requirements
- Students still have to meet the long term graduation requirements

College Credit Plus

- Delivery Options:
 - Face-to-face at HS, including interactive distance learning
 - Online
 - On campus
- All credits transferable to public schools in Ohio

- College courses appear on high school transcript
- Calculated in GPA using the 5.0 scale (students must get a C or above)
- College level work is expected
- Grades given at semester
- Athletic eligibility must meet OHSAA requirements

College Credit Plus

In a year, if:	Student may take up to:
No hs only units are scheduled	30 college credits
1 hs only unit is scheduled	27 college credits
2 hs only units are scheduled	24 college credits
3 hs only units are scheduled	21 college credits
4 hs only units are scheduled	18 college credits
5 hs only units are scheduled	15 college credits
6 hs only units are scheduled	12 college credits
7 hs only units are scheduled	9 college credits

CCP/CA

- Public colleges = no cost to student for tuition, books or fees.
- Transportation for courses off the HS campus is responsibility of the student, including parking passes, etc.
- Failing or dropping a college course after the withdraw date will result in the predetermined per credit hour cost passed onto the student
 - Also have to reimburse the cost of book(s)
- Grades and credits can be withheld until payment is made

College Credit Plus

College Entrance Requirements:

- Stark State
 - ACT Reading 18 and English 18
 - Course specific pre-requisites

CCP/CA Qualifications

College Entrance Requirements:

- University of Akron/Wayne College
 & OSU/ATI
 - 3.0 Cumulative GPA
 - ACT English 18 or 22
 Math or 22 Reading

- University of Findlay
 - 2.5 Cumulative GPA
 - ACT Comp 20 or
 - 3.0 Cumulative GPA

*Additional prerequisites for individual classes

CCP/CA Qualifications

- Only Juniors and Seniors
- Courses offered through the University of Akron, University of Findlay & Stark State
- Enrolled in at least 2
 College Academy
 courses per semester
- Open campus format
- Math courses have required math subscores

College Academy

- Classes meet 4 days a week (M-Th)
- Fridays are usually off, but instructor has authority to schedule if necessary
- At the end of each semester, students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to remain in CA
- When class is not in session, do not have to be in building. Students must report to designated areas while on campus.
- All credits transferable to public schools in Ohio. Check out <u>transferology</u>
