Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians,

Our school is following guidelines provided by the State of Ohio, the Ohio Department of Education, and the Governor as it relates to exercising caution in regards to the COVID-19. The information below includes instructional assignments for students since we will not be in school from March 16<sup>th</sup> through April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

There are assignments to help the students review lessons learned throughout this school year for each subject area. Our goal is to maintain student skills that have already been taught this school year. With this practice, students will be able to return to school and pick-up where they left off.

Each teacher has put together resources and assignments for the students either on the School Website or on Google Classroom. If assignments cannot be accessed online, paper copies will be available in the school office.

**Science:** Please complete the following assignments for science while on our extended spring break. The complete directions can be found on Google Classroom or by contacting Mrs. Hamsher or Mr. Evans at the Middle School/High School Building.

- Prepare an Invention Convention Pitch for your invention.
- Complete your Alternate Adaptations and Natural Selection Test Retakes.
- Genetics and Ethics Research and Questions
- Retest on a Previous TOPIC!

**Math:** I want to make the most of every situation, and we can do the same here. Students in eighth grade math will have the opportunity to complete one of the two assignments while working from home. Assignments other than Khan Academy may be accessed in a folder on Rittman's School Website.

- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math:
  - The first option is to continue working through Khan Academy. Students will be required to complete ten percent of 8<sup>th</sup> grade content over this time. All content that students practice should be from chapters and lessons we have already completed in school. I have recorded the percentage of each student as of 3/13/2020. The ten percent requirement will be in addition to that which is documented as of that date. Remember that Khan Academy is an excellent resource and is used for:

\*Demonstrating mastery of skill

\*Online assessments similar to those found on state testing \*Practice of skills

\*For struggling students, there is a link next to each problem that links to a detailed video explaining the mathematical concept and then demonstrates how to solve

 The second option for students, especially those without internet access, would be to complete spiral review worksheets from previously covered chapters. Each worksheet comes with an explanation of material, examples, and the required problems to be completed. There are 3 worksheets required for each week.

- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Honors Algebra:
  - Over the course of the next three weeks, honors algebra students will be continuing to work on Khan Academy to demonstrate mastery of the content we have already covered. When school resumes, we will not have class time to review past material, so it is imperative that students work through Khan Academy over this break. All honors algebra students will be required to come back with 75% of the Algebra I course complete which coincides with currently covered material (we have completed 75% of the course). Algebra students ended the third nine weeks at 60% completion, so the grade students will receive will be out of 15 and corresponds to their percentage over 60.

**Social Studies:** There are several assignments for you to complete while you are out for the following 3 weeks. The assignments are located in a folder on Rittman's School Website. Please complete and be ready to turn in when you return.

- Read the attached text "Causes of Revolution" and answer the questions that go along with it.
- Choose <u>1</u> of the following texts to read and answer the accompanying questions along with it.
  - o "Grievances"
  - "Hey King"
