

## **CAMP CHRISTOPHER CABIN RULES**

Camp Christopher is American Camp Association accredited camp used by thousands of individuals on an annual basis. In order for us to continue to serve the campers and groups at Camp Christopher, we ask your assistance on the following:

1. Please **DO NOT TOUCH** thermostats and furnaces.
2. Please **DO NOT TOUCH** the fire extinguisher unless it is an emergency.
3. Please **DO NOT TOUCH** the electrical panel.
4. Please **DO NOT TOUCH** the smoke detectors or the carbon monoxide detectors.
5. Please **CLOSE** all doors to the cabin.
6. Please **TURN OFF** all lights when not in use.
7. Please **DO NOT SMOKE** in the cabin.
8. Please **DO NOT WRITE** on any part of the cabin — **NO GRAFITTI**.
9. Please **DO NOT** have any candy, food or drink in the cabin.
10. Please **CLEAN** the cabin — throw trash where it belongs (not in the bunks), sweep as needed, empty trash.
11. Please **DO NOT** bring muddy boots and shoes in the cabin. Leave them on the porch.
12. No person shall purposely, knowingly, recklessly or negligently destroy or remove any part of any building, property, grounds or natural resources at Camp Christopher.
13. Please make sure at clean up that you are: cleaning, sweeping (floors and bunks), empty trash, lights out, doors closed in the cabin. Leave Camp in better condition than when you arrived.
14. If there is a problem in the cabin — light out, beeping or chirping detector, broken thermostat, etc. — please contact the Camp Maintenance Staff (Ranger Dave Ziga at (330) 907-5425) immediately or inform your group leader and they will contact the Staff.

We appreciate your assistance in making Camp Christopher a safer and cleaner place for all who enter.
