

Environmental Education Camper Rules

RESPECT EVERYONE IN CAMP

- Listen to other campers, chaperones, teachers, and camp staff.
- Help everyone to be able to listen. Camp Christopher uses the hands up and mouths shut signal. When a staff member, teacher or other adult raises his/her hand you are to raise yours and be quiet.
- Lights out is at 10:30 pm. Please be quiet after lights out as others need sleep and so do you.
- If you arise before 7:00 am, please remain quiet so you do not disturb others.
- Be friendly and kind to everyone at camp.

RESPECT NATURE

- Leave things in nature where you find them. Don't pick flowers, leaves, stones or sticks. Do not harass or injure wildlife.
- Do not throw trash anywhere except into the trash cans.
- If you find trash please alert our staff so we can deposit it in the nearest trash can.

RESPECT YOUR CABIN.

- Do not hang on rafters.
- Be sure the lights are out when leaving, and the door is shut.
- To keep dirt to a minimum, remove dirty shoes outside.
- Show respect to others by entering their cabin or any other buildings at camp only when given the "OK" to do so.
- Keep your cabin neat.

RESPECT THE SHOWER HOUSE.

- We all share the same bathrooms, please clean up after yourself at all times.
- Turn off faucets and shut doors.
- If you find a toilet running, notify a camp staff member immediately.

RESPECT YOURSELF.

- Keep safety in mind at all times.
- Wear shoes at all times.
- Remember to use the buddy system at ALL TIMES.
- Keep an adult in sight at all times.
- Be dressed for the weather.
- Stay away from the ponds, challenge course, beach, cliffs, and do not sit on fences.
- If you become ill or injured, let an adult know as soon as possible.
